Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

August 16, 2026

All peoples are invited to worship the Lord and to know his ways. God's gifts and his call are to Jew and Gentile alike. Jesus recognizes the universality of God's call in granting the request of the Canaanite woman.

Theme: Persistence and Never Give Up in Searching for God

20th Sunday of Ordinary Time Year A, August 16, 2026

First Reading: Isaiah: 56:1, 6-7, Second Reading: Romans 11:13-15, 29-32, Gospel: Matthew 15:21-28

Today's gospel presents us with the story of a Canaanite woman who seeks Jesus' help for her daughter who is under demonic influence. Jesus' response and the woman's faith challenge us on how to respond when we seek God's assistance in moments of need, trial, and difficulty.

This woman's love for her sick child of demonic influence is profound as this compels her to take the misery of her child as her own misery. The love she has for her child is a true reflection of God's love for us his children. God makes our own misery his own and takes our challenges upon himself. It is because of this love that made her suffer the rebuffs and insults from the hand of Jesus. It was love which made her accept the silence from Jesus without minding, it was love which made her approach Jesus even when she knew within her

herself that she was not qualified being a non-Jew. So, we can say that love for her child was the driving force in her heart and there is nothing stronger than this deep love in her heart for her child. In this way, it is this love that our Lord Jesus has for us his children that made him suffer the agony of the cross and finally gave his life for us.

Today's liturgy invites us to accept all as our brothers and sisters. It brings to our minds that God's salvation is for all. As the woman humbled and opened her heart to the Lord, the Lord helped her to grow in her faith. We have to be humbled and open ourselves to the Lord to help us grow in our faith. And through our faith, we proclaim the salvation of God to all without any distinction.

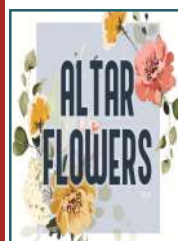

Chess, Not Checkers

There's a saying that good leaders have to play chess, not checkers.

It will surprise no one who knows me well that I am terrible at chess. It's not so much a lack of skill (although that's part of it) as a lack of effort. I find chess exhausting. To succeed at this complex game of strategy, you have to see not just the board in front of you, but the person in front of you — and more than that, you have to consider not just what is, but what could be.

I prefer checkers.

When I read a Gospel passage like today's, I think of what Jesus would be like as a chess player. It's so easy to see this account of the Canaanite woman and her tenacity and take it at face value, as a reminder to pray without ceasing, to never stop asking God for what we need. And certainly, it is that.

But it's not only that.

We see a woman begging God for help, and we see God refuse — at first. We see her persist, and we see him capitulate. At least, that's what it looks like to us.

What does it look like to Jesus?

Jesus sees this woman's face and hears her words, just as his disciples do — but he also sees her heart. He sees her whole life. He sees every moment that leads up to this one. He sees her belief, but he also sees her unbelief. He sees her wounds. He sees her daughter.

He sees the game board not just for what it is, but for what it could be.

Question:

Our prayer group is discussing ways we can change and strengthen our faith. What one thing could we change that would have the greatest impact on our faith?

Answer:

A famous coach once said that when the team is in trouble and things aren't going well, go back to the basics; when the team is winning and things are going well, go back to the basics! Any renewal program, faith development, or spiritual growth effort has to start with the basic core of what it means to believe. If the foundation is not strong, the house will not stand.

So if you work on one thing, begin with the idea that God is love, who loves us and calls us to love one another. If we really take that belief to heart, it changes how we see God, ourselves, and one another. It would change how we pray, how we treat others, and how we understand and live our own lives. Our sense of mission and purpose will be more focused on God's plan and our role in it. Love is the core of faith, the goal of life, and the hope of heaven. Whatever we do to strengthen and deepen our faith will begin and end with love.

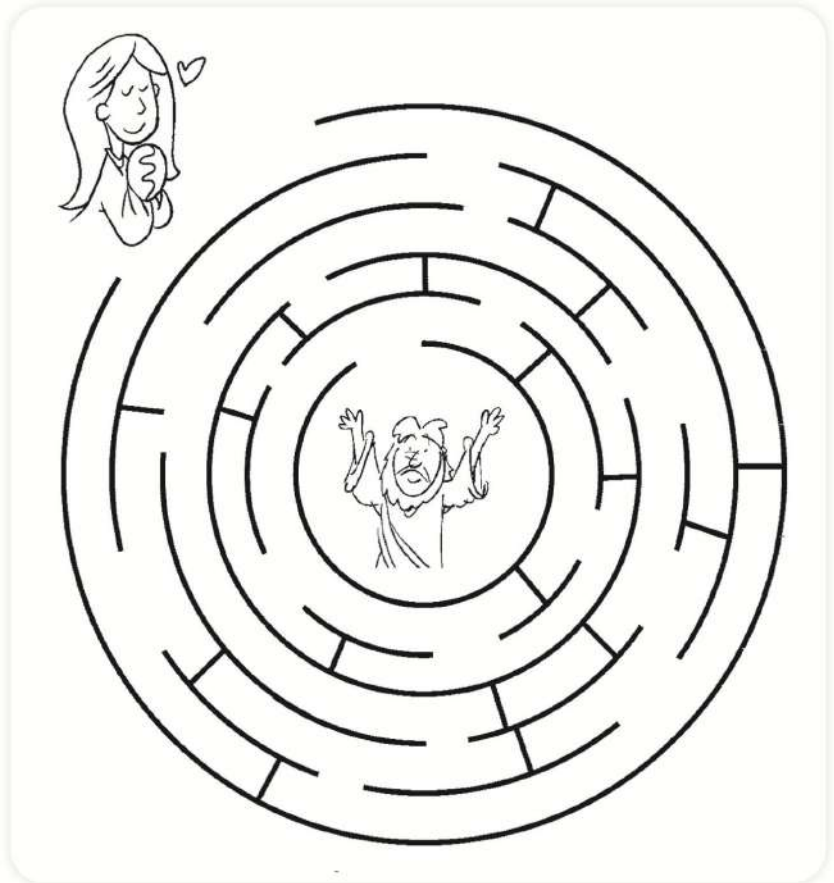
Sharing the Gospel
