BAPTISM GODPARENT CERTIFICATE

Meaning and Role of a Godparent

At the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism, Godparents are present to represent the expanded spiritual family of the child and help the parents so that children will profess the faith of their family and live up to it. A Godparent is a person who assumes, along with the parents, the responsibility for the child's faith. The purpose is to ensure that the rich and beautiful faith of the Church is passed on to the child in the most loving and authentic way possible.

As a Godparent, you must be able to live with integrity the Catholic faith handed on to you, as an example for your godchild.

Requirements of a Godparent:

1. The Godparent chosen is a practicing Catholic
2. Age: 16 years or older
3. Have received the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. Confirmation certificate must be provided.
4. If married, the Godparent's marriage is recognized as being valid by the Catholic Church. You must provide Catholic Church marriage certificate.
5. Baptismal certificate with confirmation & marriage notation included will be accepted for proof of Sacraments.
6. Godparents' signature on affidavit must be witnessed by a parish representative.
